Circumstances: Raymond's photo is aged to 38 years. He was abducted from his home by an unknown black female (sketches above). His mother, Donna Green, met the woman while she was at Grady Memorial Hospital after his birth. The woman, who called herself "Lisa Morris" spoke with Donna. Morris is described as 23 or 24 years old, 5'5" or 5'6" tall, with light skin, a small nose, full lips and dark eyes and may have a mole on her left cheek. She wore a short dark-colored leather coat. On November 6, 1978, Morris arrived uninvited to Donna's apartment. Donna let her in and about an hour later, went to take a shower, leaving Morris sitting on the couch with Raymond and Donna's brother. When Donna came out of the shower a few minutes later, Morris and Raymond were gone. Donna's brother told her that Morris had picked up Raymond and taken him outside because he was crying. A neighbor saw Morris and Raymond get into a brown vehicle which drove away. Neither Morris nor Raymond have ever been seen again, and authorities determined that all the information she provided to Donna was false. Raymond's case remains unsolved.
