Clothing/Jewelry: A diaper with Muppet characters and a cast on his right leg from knee to toe, with writing on it.

Medical: Jyrine's right leg was fractured when he disappeared. He has ostogenesis imperfecta, a rare disorder which causes brittle bones that break easily. He may be in need of medical attention.

Circumstances: Jyrine's photo at right is shown aged to 18 years. He was last seen sleeping in his bed at 1:00 a.m. in Irvington, New Jersey on June 23, 2002. He disappeared in the early hours of the morning and has never been seen again. His case remains unsolved.
